Purpose & Description: First, to ensure that all Harvest Network congregations and pastors remain faithful to the Global Alliance Covenant. Second, to facilitate regular communication with Harvest Network pastors and periodic communication with Harvest Network congregations.

We are putting a strong emphasis on relationships with pastors and their congregations.

- We see the value of mentors or partners ("coaches") or accountability partners for our Network pastors. We are designing structures and a pathway forward before implementation.
- We see the value of periodic and varied communication with Harvest Network congregations or the consistories. We are designing structures and a pathway forward before implementation.
- We see strategic and occasional contacts with pastors and churches throughout the year as very valuable.
- We see a proactive and relational ministry with our Network pastors and congregations as equal to or greater than a reactive approach.

The Prayer Team

Purpose & Description:

– To empower congregations in the Harvest Network to pray more effectively. Every congregation would have a prayer team that is taught to listen to the Holy Spirit and pray in cooperation with Him. (For example, prayer where some are getting pictures, others are praying through Scriptures as directed by the Spirit - - so that we birth those things in God's heart for Jesus' church). We gather as Prayer Champions to pray together, asking the Lord of the Harvest to raise up more workers and to see this being replicated in all of our congregations.

Partnership Contributions

The Alliance of Reformed Church's partnership expectation is that each Church contributes 3% of their income to the Denomination. Of that 3%, 1% would be sent directly to Alliance Global, and the other 2% goes separately to the Network the church has covenanted with.

Here are the steps for sending your 1% to Alliance Global

- 1. Go to arc21.org/give
- 2. Find the Partnership Offering section and select "Step1: Reach out"
- 3. A form will pop up for you to fill out and submit
- 4. Once the form is submitted, Jeff Maatman, Alliance CFO, will reach out with an email that will provide the exact title of the church in our database and instructions for setting up the account.
- 5. Once the email arrives, you can set up an account. This account will allow monthly giving to be set for regular monthly partnership offerings or allow you to login and provide a partnership offering amount each month.
- 6. Jeff will be available to coach and confirm that your account is set up correctly and answer any questions you have through this process.

Joining the Harvest Network

Once a Church affiliates with the Alliance of Reformed Churches the next step is to Join one of the Alliances Networks. As you consider which Network to belong to, here are the simple steps for Joining the Harvest Network.

1. Explore the Harvest Network. This step involves

learning more about our Mission, Vision, and Values. Then have conversations with our Staff and Board members to learn more and get to know us. Finally, discern with your Board or Consistory if the Harvest Network is the best fit for you.

2. Read our By-Laws. When a Church joins by signing the Covenant of Agreement of the Harvest Network, they will have to subscribe to our By-Laws, so it is wise to read them first.
